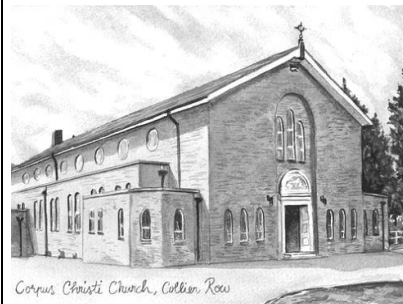

#### From the Homily at the Canonisation of St John Henry Newman

*“Such is the holiness of daily life, which Saint John Henry Newman described in these words:  
“The Christian has a deep, silent, hidden peace, which the world sees not ... The Christian is cheerful, easy, kind, gentle, courteous, candid, unassuming; has no pretence ... with so little that is unusual or striking in his bearing, that he may easily be taken at first sight for an ordinary man”  
(Parochial and Plain Sermons, V, 5).*

*Let us ask to be like that, “kindly lights” amid the encircling gloom. Jesus  
“stay with me, and then I shall begin to shine as Thou shinest: so to shine as to be a light to others”  
(Meditations on Christian Doctrine, VII, 3). Amen.*
