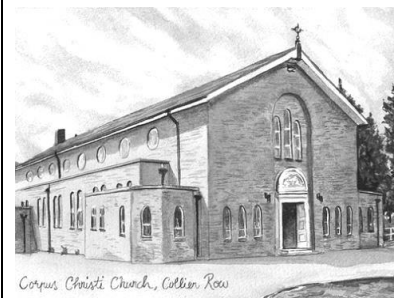

- Give an appropriate amount to a charity of your choice, or support "Mary's Meals" - our Lenten Offerings Appeal. There is a basket at the back of the church throughout Lent.
