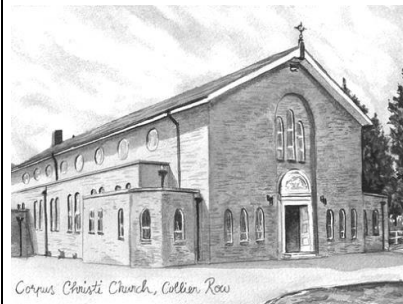

### YOUR OFFERINGS

### LENT OFFERINGS FOR MARY'S MEALS

The total raised from our Lent Offerings came to £920.21. Mary's Meals provides nutritious meals for children in places of learning in some of the poorest parts of the world. Our offerings will go a long way – sufficient for 13,145 meals or for 66 children to receive a nutritious meal in a place of education, every day for a whole school year. Many thanks to a young lady in the Parish, who wishes to remain anonymous, who raised an additional £1500 at her place of work, a great achievement.

### GIFT AID LETTERS

In previous years we have left out letters confirming the amounts donated in the last tax year for people to collect at the back of the Church. The new General Data Protection Regulation rules make it difficult for this to happen now.
