Monday is the **Memorial of the Seven Holy Founders of the Servite Order** - the religious order of the 'Servants of Mary' (or Servites) had its beginning with these seven men at Florence, seven centuries ago. The Servites are particularly devoted to Our Lady's Sorrows.

Friday is the **Memorial of St Peter Damian** - an Italian eleventh century reforming Benedictine monk and cardinal. He was venerated as a saint soon after his death in 1072 and was proclaimed a Doctor of the Church in 1828.
