### A MESSAGE FROM FATHER PHILIP for parents of children in Year 5

In the autumn term, you will be required to apply for a secondary school place for your child for September 2020. If your child is a baptised Catholic and you are intending to apply for one or more Catholic secondary schools, you will be required to obtain a **Certificate of Catholic Practice** from the priest of the church where you normally attend Sunday Mass. If you are intending to ask me for this certificate, it is most important that I know who you and your child are, and that I know that it is your usual custom to attend weekly Sunday Mass (this includes Saturday evening Mass.) Do not assume that, if you slip in discreetly at the back of church during Mass, I will recognise you. If you think I should know who you are but might have forgotten, please remind me! If you have any questions about this process, please do not hesitate to ask me.

### THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR THIS WEEK . . .

Thursday is the **Memorial of St Alban**, protomartyr of Britain – the first known martyr of our country; he was put to death during a persecution sometime in the third century. St Alban's Abbey (now a cathedral) marks the traditional site of his death.

Friday is the **Memorial of St Aloysius Gonzaga** - this good young man joined the Jesuits, wanting to be a priest. But in 1591, at the age of twenty-three, he died from the plague which he caught while nursing its victims.

Saturday is the **National Feast of SS John Fisher and Thomas More** – John Fisher is best known for his martyrdom under Henry VIII in 1535; he also deserves to be admired for his outstanding example as a pastor. Bishop of Rochester, his first concern was always for the people entrusted to his care. Thomas More was a great Englishman, statesman, scholar and saint. His own words on the scaffold are now famous: "I die the King's good servant, but God's first". He was able to face death in this way – because that was the way he had lived.
