*This is the most important week of the entire year –  
the final days of Lent and then the great three days: the Triduum.*

*Lent comes quietly to its close as the sun sets on Maundy Thursday.  
The very heart of our year, and centre of our lives, is the annual celebration  
of the death and resurrection of the Lord: the Paschal Triduum.*


*It begins on Maundy Thursday evening  
and lasts right through to Easter Sunday evening.*

*During these three days we keep one festival, our Passover, our Easter.  
We remember the Passover of Jesus in Jerusalem –  
his passing-over through death  
to the glory of resurrection life.*

*But we are not merely keeping an anniversary.*

*As we remember these days in the life of the Lord, we call on God to remember.  
God is eternal and transcends time;  
when he remembers an event in human history  
it is, for God, happening now – all time is now for him.  
God remembers the Passover of his Christ  
and God, in communion with his Church, makes it now for us.*

*In the liturgy we frequently hear words that express this:  
“Today”, “On this day”, “This is the night”.*



*These days are not a preparation for Easter Day – they are Easter.  
And more than that – they are the first Easter made present to us  
at Corpus Christi in 2022.*
