## APPLICATIONS TO CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOLS

Parents who wish to apply for places in Catholic schools will need to obtain a "Certificate of Catholic Practice" from the parish priest of the place at which they attend Sunday Mass. The Certificate is evidence that a family practises the Catholic Faith - which includes **attendance at Sunday Mass for the past five years** (on Saturday evening or Sunday). This is a requirement throughout England & Wales. You will need an appointment with Father Philip to discuss whether such a Certificate can be issued. To arrange this, please telephone the Parish Office.

## THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR THIS WEEK . . .

Monday is the **Memorial of St Francis Xavier** - one of the very first Jesuits and, after St Ignatius himself, a most outstanding priest. Although only 46 when he died in 1552, his preaching in the Far East has established him as one of the Church's patrons of the Missions.

Thursday is the **Parish Solemnity of the Dedication of the Church** - on this day in 1979, our church was dedicated by Bishop Patrick Casey. We give thanks for this building, for those pioneers who had the inspiration and worked so hard to create it and for all who have built up the community that is the People of God, the Church, here at Corpus Christi.

Thursday is also the **Memorial of St Nicholas** - according to tradition, a fourth century bishop in what is now Turkey. He is still popular in parts of Europe where children receive presents on his feastday. 'Santa Claus' is derived from a form of his name.

Friday is the **Memorial of St Ambrose** - a fearless defender of the Faith, who became Bishop of Milan in the year 374 and was very much a pastor to his people. He had a great deal to do with the conversion of St Augustine of Hippo - one of the most influential theologians in the history of the Church.

Saturday morning is the **Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary** - from the very first moments of her existence, in the womb of her mother, St Anne, Our Lady was preserved from the state of Original Sin: she was 'full of grace'. Blessed Pope Paul VI wrote that this feast, falling as it does early in Advent, is also the 'basic preparation for the coming of the Saviour, as well as the happy beginning of the Church, without spot or wrinkle'.
